

## May 6, 2023 “There has to be a Song”

### IC, CC, HC Performance Guide

- Time:** Intermezzo/Concert/Honors arrive **12:30** (leave coat in the car) Concert begins at 2pm and should be finished around 3:30.
- Be sure your singer eats and goes to the bathroom **before** coming to Immanuel Lutheran Church.
- Where:** Main Sanctuary - 200 N Plum Grove Rd, Palatine, IL 60067
- Wear:** Concert clothes. Singers should NOT wear cologne of any kind or visible jewelry. That includes yarn bracelets, WATCHES, and anklets.
- Appearance:** Ready to walk on stage (and that means hair pulled back and secured with pins) also means NO NAIL POLISH except clear or French manicure
- Check our website for appearance details.
- Only singers in the proper uniform and following appearance guidelines may perform.
- Sign In:** In the lobby, then move into the Sanctuary.
- Bring:** Water bottle with secure top and a small snack. **Be sure your singer eats a good lunch before coming to Immanuel Lutheran.** Singers who feel sick on stage usually haven't eaten.
- Singers should NOT bring phones. They will be in an unsecured area all afternoon.
- Music:** Only singers who have turned in their music may perform.
- Tickets:** Available NOW on the Cutting Hall website [www.Cuttinghall.org](http://www.Cuttinghall.org) or by calling 847-202-5222. Doors to the Sanctuary will open at 1:40 for the general public for the concert.
- Flowers:** Pick them up in the lobby outside the entrance to the Sanctuary **when you arrive.**
- Recording:** Are you video recording? You must be in the balcony to record on any device, this means cell phones, iPads and video cameras.
- This concert will be professionally (audio) recorded.
- Late?** You may enter only between songs.
- Illness:** If your singer isn't feeling well on concert day ☹️ **keep him or her home.** Just email Melissa to let us know.
