- Time:** Singers should be in their seats at 12:30. Singers leave their coats with their parents. They will already know where their seats are. (So that means singers should arrive by 12:25 so they can get their uniforms checked.)
- Wear:** Girls wear their concert dresses from Formal Fashions. Their hair should be pulled back off their faces. No jewelry, nail polish, face glitter, yarn necklaces, bracelets, or ankle bracelets, or stickers on your face, please. Wear **nude panty hose** and plain black ballet flats. Clean hair and hands!
- Boys wear concert uniform from Formal Fashions, black socks, black belt if necessary, black dress shoes, and burgundy tie. Have clean hair and hands!
- Bring:** nothing but smiles ☺
- Concert:** We'll begin at 2:00 and end by 3:30 or so. Doors will open for the audience at 1:40. Video taping of any kind is only allowed in the balcony
- Pictures:** You'll have a chance to take pictures of each group after the concert.
